Prevent adult use disorders associated with cannabis and the abuse of cannabis by adults.</li> <li>3. Promote the health and safety of the public, equitably.</li> <li>4. Prevent the unlawful production, distribution and sale of cannabis, equitably.</li> <li>5. Protect the peace, comfort, and safety of county neighborhoods.</li> <li>6.
