

- 32-C.** Recommendation as submitted by Supervisors Antonovich and Solis: Establish a Medical Marijuana Dispensary Enforcement Team (MMDET), comprised of the Director of Planning, County Counsel, the Sheriff and the District Attorney and others, as necessary; direct the Chief Executive Officer to identify funding for one full-time attorney who shall be dedicated to this effort; instruct County Counsel to place the amended County Code, Title 22 - Planning and Zoning, banning medical marijuana dispensaries in the County's unincorporated areas, as requested by the District Attorney, on the Board's agenda for consideration in two weeks; and direct the MMDET to report back to the Board within four months on the status of the County's efforts to effectively and expeditiously close down illegal medical marijuana dispensaries in the County's unincorporated areas, including the status of filling the full-time attorney position and the impact of the amended County Code.
